# OVERVIEW

## **Tawang Bike Tour**

The Tawang Bike Tour is a high-altitude motorcycle expedition through the Eastern Himalayas of Arunachal Pradesh, starting and ending in Guwahati. This journey takes riders from the plains of Assam into remote Himalayan terrain, crossing iconic mountain passes like Sela Pass and Bum La Pass, and reaching the culturally rich town of Tawang.

The tour blends adventure riding, high-altitude landscapes, Buddhist heritage, and untouched mountain roads, making it one of India's most rewarding and lesser-explored motorcycle circuits. Riders experience dramatic altitude changes, alpine lakes, monasteries, waterfalls, and border roads rarely accessed by casual travelers.

# Arrival at Guwahati | Expedition Kick-off

**Arrive in Guwahati and check in to the hotel. Spend the day settling in after travel and meeting the MotoTour team. In the evening, riders gather for introductions, a short expedition briefing, and an overview of the riding days ahead. The rest of the night is relaxed, ideal for rest before the journey begins.**

**Altitude:** 50-90 meters (300 ft) Flat terrain with minimal altitude change.



# Guwahati to Kaziranga National Park | Rolling Through the Plains

The ride begins on smooth highways from Guwahati into Assam's scenic countryside. Enjoy green April views, tea gardens, and peaceful small towns along the way. By afternoon, reach Kaziranga and check in near the forest zone. If possible, do the jungle safari today, as tomorrow's ride is long.

## Day Highlights:

- First riding day of the expedition
- Tea estates and Assam countryside
- Entry into the Kaziranga forest belt
- Overnight : Kaziranga



**Altitude:** 50-90 meters (300 ft) Flat terrain with minimal altitude change.



# Kaziranga Safari & Ride to Bomdila | Hills Ahead

Early morning, riders go for a Kaziranga jungle safari and return for breakfast. Then the ride continues towards Arunachal Pradesh, crossing Tezpur and Bhalukpong. As the journey climbs, roads become twisty and cooler, with scenic forests and rivers along the way. Reach Bomdila by evening.

## Day Highlights:

- Morning wildlife safari
- Entry into Arunachal Pradesh
- First mountain roads of the journey
- Overnight : Bomdila



**Altitude:** 2,415 meters (7,900 ft) First major altitude gain. Riders may feel mild cold.



# Bomdila to Tawang via Sela Pass | Mountain Riding Day

**The ride from Bomdila climbs into higher Himalayan terrain toward Sela Pass (13,700 ft), offering stunning panoramic mountain views. After crossing the pass, the road descends into the Tawang valley, and you reach Tawang by late afternoon.**

## Day Highlights:

- Mountain ascent from Bomdila
- Crossing Sela Pass (13,700 ft)
- Entry into the Tawang valley
- Overnight : Tawang



**Altitude:** Sela Pass: 4,170 meters (13,700 ft) This is the most dramatic ascent day of the tour.




## Tawang to Bum La Pass, Madhuri Lake & PT Tso Lake

**Today's ride explores Tawang's high-altitude beauty, heading towards Bum La Pass past army settlements and open landscapes. After time near the border, visit Madhuri Lake with its stunning blue waters, then stop at the peaceful PT Tso Lake. Return to Tawang by evening.**

### Day Highlights:

- Visit to the Indo-China border region at Bum La
- Madhuri Lake (Sangetsar Tso)
- PT Tso Lake
- Overnight : Tawang



**Altitude:** 4,633 meters (15,200 ft)

High altitude day. Slow riding and hydration are essential.



# Tawang Local Run | Culture & Easy Miles

**A relaxed day exploring Tawang town and its highlights. Visit Tawang Monastery, Chakzam Suspension Bridge, and the giant Buddha statue. In the evening, attend the War Memorial light & sound show.**

## **Day Highlights:**

- Tawang Monastery
- Chakzam bridge
- War Memorial light and sound show
- Overnight : Tawang



**Altitude:** 3,100 meters (10,200 ft) No major altitude gain or loss.




# Tawang to Dirang via Jung Waterfall | Riding Downhill

**The ride begins the descent from the mountains, passing through forests and valleys with a stop at Jung (Nuranang) Waterfall. Enjoy scenic April greenery and rivers along the way. Reach Dirang by afternoon.**

## Day Highlights:

- Ride past Jang Waterfall
- Pass traditional villages and terraced fields
- Enter the warmer Dirang Valley
- Distance: 140 km
- Overnight stay : Dirang



**Altitude:** 1,620 meters (5,315 ft) Oxygen levels improve; weather becomes warmer.



## Dirang to Guwahati via Shergaon | Return to the Plains

**Depart early from Dirang, riding through Shergaon's meadows and villages before descending to Tezpur. From there, follow the highway back to Guwahati, arriving by evening and completing the circuit.**

### Day Highlights:

- Mixed terrain: hills, forests, and highways
- Scenic countryside through Assam
- Arrival in Guwahati by evening
- Distance: 320 km
- Overnight: Guwahati



**Altitude:** 55 m Long descent from hills to plains.



## Departure from Guwahati

**After breakfast, riders depart for the airport or railway station. The expedition comes to an end with memories of long riding days, mountain passes, forest roads, and the unique landscapes of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh.**

- End of the Northeast bike expedition

- **Extra room, Food cost incurred due to delayed travel.**
- **Cost Of Any Spare Part Which Will Be Used Due To The Accidental Damage Incurred When The Motorbike Is In Rider's Possession.**
- **Cost Incurred To Transfer Or Tow The Motorbike In Case It Is Dropped On The Way.**
- **Any lunch / Snack and other meals not mentioned in Package Inclusions.**
- **Any Airfare / Rail fare other than what is mentioned in "Inclusions" or any type of transportation from Guwahati to Guwahati.**
- **Additional Costs due to Flight Cancellations, Landslides, Roadblocks, and other natural calamities.**
- **A security deposit of Rs. 5,000/- per motorbike. As per the deposit policy, this amount is refundable if there is no damage or spare parts used by the end of the trip. The Amount will be refunded instantly.**

## THINGS TO CARRY

- **Valid driving license & photo ID**
- **Riding gear: gloves, riding boots**
- **Warm clothing: thermals, fleece/down jacket.**
- **Rainwear, windproof layer.**
- **Personal medicines & basic first-aid**
- **Sunscreen, lip balm, sunglasses**
- **Mobile phone, charger & power bank**
- **Comfortable clothes for evenings**
- **Small backpack or daypack for essentials**
- **Reusable water bottle / hydration pack**
- **Energy bars or dry snacks**

**Tip:** Weather and altitude can change quickly—layered clothing and hydration are essential.



## **Note :**

- Check-in time is 12:00 noon; early check-in is subject to room availability.
- A minimum of 4 riders is required to operate a batch. The company reserves the right to cancel the tour if the minimum is not met.
- Any additional expenses due to weather conditions, road closures, landslides, permit issues, flight delays, or changes in accommodation/transport will be borne by the guest.
- The itinerary may change depending on weather, road conditions, border permissions, or local authority restrictions.
- If a rider chooses to leave the tour mid-way, all extra transportation or logistics costs from that point onward must be paid by the rider.
- Riders must carry a valid driving license and government-issued photo ID for hotel check-in and inner-line permits.
- Bum La Pass visit is subject to permits and weather conditions and is not guaranteed.
- Any damage caused by the rider to the motorcycle, hotel property, or support vehicle will be directly chargeable.
- Booking amount is valid only for the specified season and batch dates.
- If a rider cancels upon arrival or chooses not to join the ride, full tour charges apply.
- The company may cancel the departure due to insufficient group size; in such cases, a full refund of the booking amount will be provided.
- Riders must carry personal medicines; basic first-aid support will be available.
- The tour leader's instructions are mandatory, especially in high-altitude and border areas.
- In case of an emergency or if a rider feels unwell due to altitude or weather, the team will arrange safe assistance and necessary support.

## **Payment policy:**

- Rs.10,000/- of the Total Billing Amount to be deposited as the booking amount at the time of the booking

## **Cancellation policy:**

- Booking Amount of 10,000/person is non-refundable.

## Rescheduling Policy:

In case you are unable to travel as planned and need to reschedule your date of travel:

Before 15 Days from the Date of Travel - One-time Complementary.

Within 15 Days from the Date of Travel - The cost of rescheduling needs to be paid by the guest subject to amendment charges from hotels and transporters.
